WSCC Pool Rules & Regulations

Pool Hours:

Monday-Saturday 11-6 pm | Sunday 1-7 pm Pool opens Memorial weekend through Labor Day

Life Guards On-Duty

Monday-Saturday. 12-4 pm Sunday 1-5 pm (Swim at your own risk during all other pool hours.)

Guests

- The pool is open to all WSCC members. Members may bring as many guests as they would like during the summer, however the same guest is only allowed 3 times during a summer. Out of town visiting grandchildren may come unlimited (guest fee applies).
- ALL guests (in-town, out-of-town, extended family, children, in-town/out- of town grandchildren) are \$5 each per day. Exceptions: There is no charge for one babysitter of member's children and all toddlers (3 & under).
- All guest fees will be charged to the sponsoring member's account.
- Guest must be accompanied and signed-in by the Sponsoring Member Only.
- Widowed grandparent can be included on your membership at no additional fee.

Sign-In

 All members and their guests must register with the pool staff upon arrival. The sign-in chart will be at entrance gate.

Children

When lifeguards are on or off duty, children under the age of 12 years must be accompanied by an adult or a responsible individual 16 years of age or older, unless the child has sufficiently passed a swimming test conducted by the lifeguard. Children 8 & under must be supervised by an adult or one at least 16 years of age.

For Health Sake

- Any person with a contagious disease, (such as pink-eye) open sores, cuts, or wearing a bandage for any reason will not be allowed to swim in the pool until the condition clears.
- Regular diapers are not allowed in the large swimming pool and babies must have their "bottoms" covered at all times. Children 3 & under are required to wear "swim diapers" before entering the waters.

Conduct

- WATER GUNS of any type are prohibited from the swimming pool due to the hazards they have created in the years past and in effort to avoid future accidents.
- The lifeguard on duty will specify the type of personal swim gear appropriate for the use in the pool. This is often determined by the number of swimmers and patrons using the pool at a given time.
- Running, horseplay, or breaking of any pool rules will not be tolerated. Procedures for disciplinary action of violators is as follows:
 - **1st** A warning will be issued
 - **2nd** Violators will be restricted from pool use and sit out a minimum of 15 minutes in designated area
 - <u>3rd</u> Parent will be called and the violator will be restricted from the pool for a period of time as determined by the lifeguard or pool manager.

Pool Break

There will be a "pool break" every hour for 15 minutes and the pool must be cleared at this time. Primarily, POOL BREAK is a "time out" for swimmers. It is also a privileged swimming time for adults at least 21 years of age or infants accompanied by a parent. During this time, patrons are

<u>Safety</u>

- Equipment that is not suitable for swimming activities such as golf clubs, golf balls, bicycles, etc., are not allowed in the pool area in order to eliminate potential hazards.
- Pets are not allowed in pool area.
- The pool will be cleared or closed due to hazardous or potentially violent weather. The lifeguard will
 determine the length of time and place to wait out the duration of any storm. If bad weather persists,
 the pool may be closed.
- No pets allowed in pool area.

Lifeguards

- All rules and regulations have been established and approved by the management at WSCC and will be strictly enforced by the life guarding staff. They are responsible for protecting lives and preventing accidents. Therefore, entertaining and continually disciplining children do not fall under life guarding responsibilities.
- All WSCC Lifeguards are certified in Lifeguard Training, CPR, & First Aid

Food/Beverage

- ALL FOOD AND BEVERAGES on the premises of WSCC must be purchased by means of snackbar/grill, which is open 7 days a week. It is acceptable to only bring food for special diets, infants or toddlers.
- NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES OR GLASS CONTAINERS are allowed in the pool area at any time.
 This regulation will be strictly enforced.
- NO SMOKING allowed in the pool area at anytime
- All swimmers must utilize designated tables located within the pool area or the snackbar patio for eating.
- No food or drinks are allowed within 10 feet in the perimeter of the swimming pool. Diners are responsible for the immediate disposal of their trash.
- Swimmers must dry off and wear cover-ups/shoes when entering the clubhouse or snackbar/grill. If wet, damp, or oily from suntan lotion, utilize the outdoor patio adjacent to the snackbar/grill or designated eating areas located within the pool area.
- All members will be charged a \$10 food/beverage monthly minimum. You may charge food/beverage purchase in pro shop or snack bar grill.

Private Parties

WSCC swimming pool may be reserved before or after pool hours upon availability. You may make arrangements by contacting the club office at 252-399-9164. There is no rental charge to WSCC members. However, you must hire 2 WSCC lifeguards and a \$5 guest fee will apply for every non-member present within the pool area.

Swim at Your Own Risk Ruling

- Members only of WSCC have the privilege to use the pool during the extended hours of 8am-11am and 6pm-8:30pm (no guard on duty) if the pool is not being utilized for a private pool party. You must stop by the proshop and sign a waiver to utilize the pool at these times. The WSCC proshop will close at 6pm, so you must check in by then to avoid being locked out of the pool gate in the evenings. You must be at least 21 years old to qualify. Adults must accompany their own children and assume responsibility for them. The last person out must pad lock the front pool gate. No Guests will be allowed when guards are off duty.
